**15TH ANNUAL
FRAYSER HOLIDAY PARADE
“A HOLIDAY STORY”
*OFFICIAL PARADE RULES***

1. Parade entry registration shall only be accepted in writing, via either a completed Official Registration Form
2. Parade Marshals will be on duty in each staging area as well as at various locations along the parade route to ensure the smooth and orderly progression of the setup and of the parade itself. Parade Marshals will have the authority to remove any unit (entry) causing a delay, violating official festival parade rules, or failing to cooperate.
3. Parade line-up and staging will begin at 10:30 am, Saturday, December 7, 2024, in the Watkins Plaza parking at Watkins and Burnham. All entries must be in position and ready by 11:30am.
4. All units (entries) must check-in upon arrival with a Parade Marshal and be directed to their assigned staging area. All units (entries) must keep a representative with the entry at all times within the assigned staging area.
5. Participants must provide current and information describing their group, for the parade narrator, upon arrival. (Will be used to inform media and spectators about group)
6. Parade will promptly begin at 12:00 pm, Saturday, December 7, 2024, from the staging area described in #3 above.
7. The use of alcoholic beverages, prior to or the possession of during the parade, by any unit/entry member, is strictly forbidden.
8. Under no circumstances shall any participant, unit, or entry move to a different position within the parade line-up, before or during the parade, except under the direction of a Parade Marshal. Riding participants will not be permitted to jump off and back on units/entries while the parade is in progress.
9. Proper unit spacing and parade pace is critical. Parade speed will maintain approximately four (4) feet per second. Voluntary stopping for drill formation, reverse marching by bands or drill teams cannot exceed 5 minutes, unless directed by a parade marshall.
10. Participants riding in vehicles or trailers must provide their own vehicles and drivers. Insurance and liability are the sole responsibility of participants who are driving/riding in vehicles.
11. One Support vehicle for marching units will be allowed with the marching unit, in the parade. Parade participants are expected to conduct themselves in a courteous manner.
12. Candy may be SAFELY given or tossed (NEVER THROWN OVER-HANDED) to the parade spectators. Any participants caught throwing candy or objects with the intent to harm any person or group, will be asked to exit the parade.
13. Any unit whose sole purpose, as determined by the Parade Committee, is for advertising only, must meet these specific guidelines: Participants must provide their own signage; (b) Signs must be in good taste, or they will be disallowed.
14. These rules are subject to change on short notice. Advance notice will be given appropriately.
15. Failure to comply with the parade rules will result in unit member or entire unit (entry) removal from the parade (even if in progress)and/or future participation banning.

FRAYSER HOLIDAY PARADE WAIVER

The undersigned, agrees to participate in the Frayser Holiday Parade on Saturday, December 7, 2024, beginning at 12:00 p.m. I / We (_____), shall/will abide by the rules established by the Parade Committee and cooperate in every way possible to assure an event which will earn maximum public approval. I / We (_____) agree to release, indemnify, and/or hold harmless - the Frayser Community Advisory Committee, the City of Memphis, Tennessee, any event sponsors, representatives or agents of the event - from all direct and indirect claims for injury or damages suffered by me in the Frayser Holiday Parade, as well as for punitive damages, even if resulting from gross negligence. This release is expressly intended to relieve from liability those who promote, organize or assist in the Frayser Holiday Parade, and is intended to bind my heirs, survivors, administrators and executors.

I certify that I have the authority to enter into this agreement on behalf of the entity or organization described above. I am executing this agreement on its behalf. We understand and agree to abide by all the aforementioned rules and guidelines to participation in the Frayser Holiday Parade.
